

Please see below for Kindergarten/TK enrollment information:

Kindergarten:

- In order to be eligible for K, your child must be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2026. (CA State Law).
- Kindergarten opportunities are available at all 4 of our elementary schools (Tahoe Valley, Sierra House, Meyers, and Bijou*). We have space limitations so register early.
- Bijou is a Two Way Bilingual Immersion program and admits students through a lottery process. Commitment forms are due by February 13th, 2026.

Transitional Kindergarten (TK):

- In order to be eligible for TK, your child must turn 4 years old by September 1st, 2026
- TK opportunities are available at the following sites - space limitations so register early.
 - Tahoe Valley Elementary
 - Meyers Elementary
 - Sierra House Elementary
 - Bijou Community School (filled in February through a lottery process.)

The following documents are required to complete TK & K enrollment.

Your school will contact you to make an appointment to bring your child in for an initial assessment, as well as turn in paperwork at the same time. (You can pick up hard copies at any elementary school.)

1. Child's birth certificate. (CA Law)
2. Proof of immunizations. *Children will not be enrolled in school without presenting an up-to-date immunization record. (CA Law). For more information regarding required immunizations for California public schools, please [click here](#).*
3. Health examination (please schedule with your family Physician). **(no longer required, but recommended)**
4. Oral health examination (dental examinations that have occurred in the last 12 months meet this requirement). (CA Law)
5. Proof of California residency (lease agreement, mortgage statement, or utility statement)

We look forward to welcoming all of our new families to LTUSD. Our first day of school for the 2026-2027 school year is Monday, August 24, 2026.
